Permits may be purchased for an annual fee of \$200



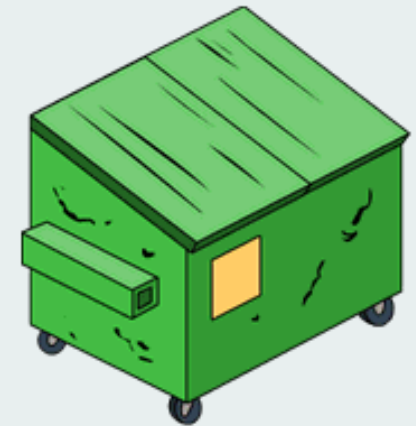

## What does this mean for you?

- You will receive the same benefits of having a local collection site.
- You will no longer have to separate recyclables by material. All acceptable items will be put together in one compactor.
- You will be able to get rid of waste oil, antifreeze, and oil filters for no fee.
- Lawn, garden waste and brush will be accepted. **NO STUMPS.**
- Appliances, tires, construction and demolition, electronics, carpet and padding, larger mixed plastics, mattresses and box springs will be charged a fee for disposal.
- Larger items you do not want to bring to the dump or items not accepted, can be picked up by Menomonie Disposal for a fee. *For pick up, call 715-235-9511*

## RECYCLE - IT'S THE LAW

### WHAT IS AN ACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLE?

- Clean corrugated cardboard
- Aluminum cans
- #1 bottles, #2 bottles, glass bottles and jars. Please remove covers from bottles and jars
- Cardboard packaging that does not need to be refrigerated or frozen. No TV dinners, frozen pizza, pop/beer cartons, etc...
- Mixed paper, newspaper, magazines, soft cover books, junk mail, envelopes, and office paper
- DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES

### WHAT IS AN UNACCEPTABLE RECYCLABLE?

- #3,4,5,6,7,8, or 9 plastic
- #1 clam shells, berry boxes etc..
- Drinking glasses, plate glass, candles, vases etc...
- Wrapping paper will go in regular trash
- Plastic bags should go back to the store you received them from
- NO ANIMAL CARCASSES

## REMINDERS

- Please see an attendant before throwing anything from your vehicle.
- If it took more than one person to load your item, please bring someone with to help unload.
- We do not accept freezers, refrigerators, water coolers, drinking fountains, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, or polyfoam spray systems.
- Liquid and solid chemicals and hazardous materials, such as paint, cleaning supplies solvents, fuels, will not be accepted and strictly prohibited.
- All medications are strictly prohibited. Please contact the Boyceville Police Dept or Dunn County Sherriff office to see where you can bring medications.
- Make sure to display your 2021 collection site permit each time you visit
- Gas grills will be taken for a fee of \$5.
