Dog Licensing Information for the Village of Downing

Any dog of licensing age (five months or older) residing in the Village of Downing must be licensed no matter when acquired during the year. Dog licenses expire on December 31 of the current year as provided by the provisions of Chapter 174.05 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Renewal reminder letters are mailed in mid-December with property tax bills and sewer/trash statements. Regardless of receipt of the letter, it remains your personal responsibility to take care of getting your dog(s) license renewed.

License & Renewal Process

- Complete the Dog License Application
 (on our website or email <u>Treasurer@DowningWl.com</u> to request a copy)
- Return the completed Dog License Application form along with:
 - Total Fees (see back for fee details)
 - Current rabies certificate
 - Self-addressed, stamped envelope not required if making the request in person.
- Your receipt, current dog license, collar tag (to be secured on the dog collar), and rabies certificate will be returned.

If you no longer have your dog, please complete the form on the back of this letter to submit proper documentation of the reason or send an email to Treasurer@DowningWI.com. Thank you for keeping our records current.

NEW dogs to your household

- For new dogs over the age of 5 months, (not in the database) the fee remains the same throughout the year (see back for fee details).
- Dogs must be registered within 30 days of acquiring ownership to avoid late fees.
- Follow License & Renewal Process above.

Rabies Vaccination and License Renewal

<u>Your dogs' rabies vaccination must be up to date before your license can be issued</u>. If the vaccination EXPIRES in the month of January, February, or March, your pet must get a rabies booster before their license can be renewed.
